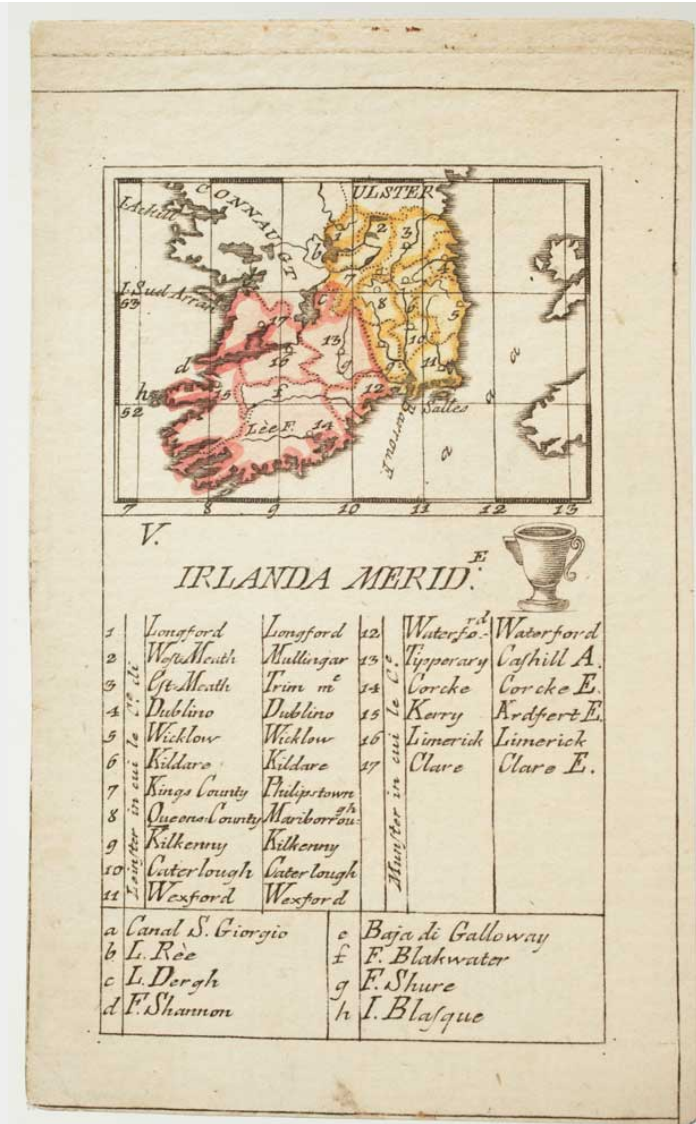


AN 18TH CENTURY PLAYING-CARD MAP OF SOUTHERN IRELAND

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

A rare miniature map of southern Ireland engraved by Lamberti for the 'Minchiate', the Florentine

version of the Tarot, which had each card marked with an arcane symbol. The full set was published in Augusto Da Rabatta and Jean Baptiste De Baillou's pocket atlas 'Nuovo Atlante Generale'.

Information on the map is minimal, but an extensive key gives the names of the various regions and waterways.
