Product Description

An unrecorded plan of Marylebone, showing from Notting Hill Gate (still called 'Kensington Gravel Pitts') bottom left, clockwise to Hampstead, Highgate, Upper Holloway, King's Cross, Grays Inn Land Oxford Street. A series of concentric circles, a quarter of a mile apart, radiate from a blank area of the map between Chalk Farm and the Regents Canal, suggesting the map was produced for the development of that area.
