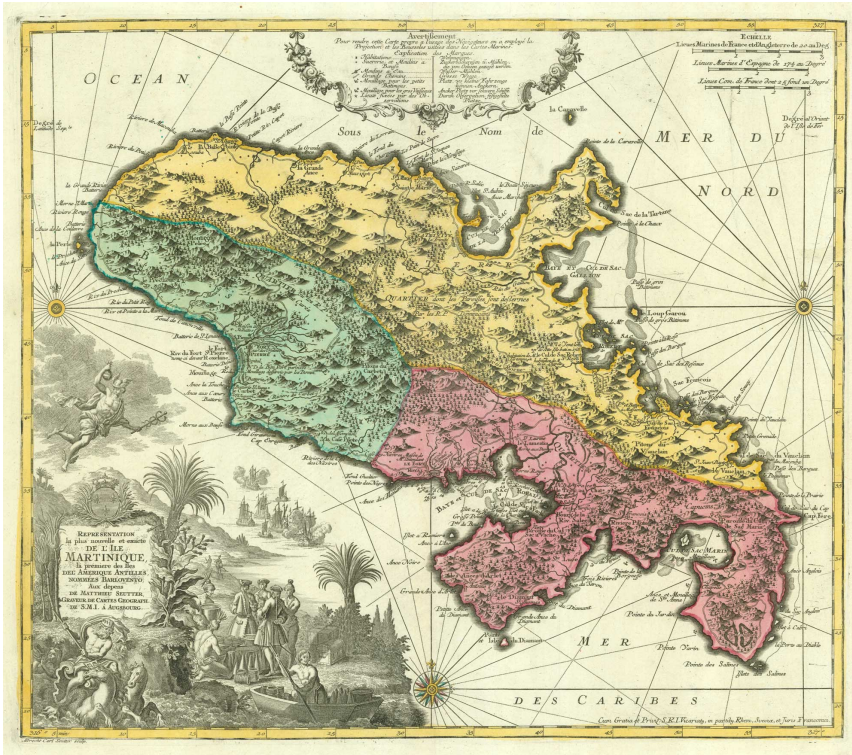




18th century map of Martinique in fine colour
