A detailed map of the Malaysian peninsula and the Straits of Sincapura. Above the Tropic of Cancer, the mythical lake of Chaamay is shown. "For many years Chiang Mai was a complete blank to the west. The one definite fact, all seem to have agreed, was that there was a great lake 'Chaammay Lake, the famous geographer Herman Moll called it on his c.1700 map of India beyond the Ganges ' from which flowed, so it was thought, several great rivers, amongst them the Irrawaddy. Of course this lake did not exist."
