A very scarce map of Cyprus with Roman names, decorated with a title cartouche of mer-people. It is based on Jansson's interpretation of the map in the 'Parergon', Ortlelius's classical atlas. First published by Pierre Mortier in 1705, this example has the imprint of his successors and was originally issued by them in J. Leclerc's 'Atlas Antiquus, sacer ecclesiasticus et profanus'.
