Map of Korea, Liaodong, and the tip of Shantung Province, prepared by Thomas Kitchin for Thomas Salmon's Universal Traveller and based on D'Anville's landmark map of 1735. The map is of interest for the use of 'Sea of Korea', the sea between Korea and Japan. Other interesting information is the mentioning of the Palisade or Wooden Wall that separates Mongolia from Quantong Province.

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
