A large map of the British Isles, with two insets: the Orkneys & Shetlands, and the Channel Islands. The colour delineates the counties, with red lines for the railways. Although the map is dated 1840 the hand colouring seems to have been added a decade later, as one of the railways marked is the Dublin-Kilkenny line, run by the Great Southern and Western Railway Company.

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
