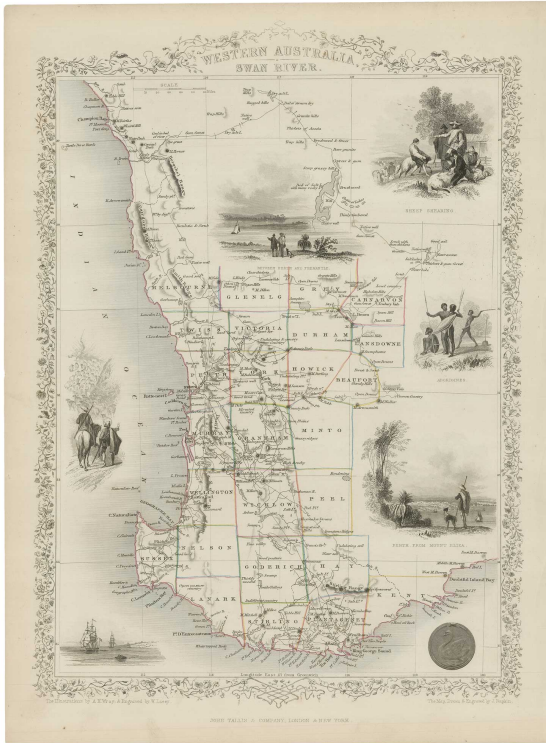




A mid 19th century map of Western Australia with vignettes
