A detailed Victorian map of Spain and Portugal within an ornate printed border and decorated with vignettes including prospects of Madrid & Lisbon, Flamenco dancing and a bullfight. The map was drawn and engraved by John Rapkin for the 'The Illustrated Atlas, and Modern History of the World, Geographical Political, Commercial & Statistical', edited by Montgomery Martin, which was one of the last decorative atlases to be published.

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
