A decorative steel-engraved map of North America, published in the Atlas Universel Illustré, with a highly decorative engraved border. Vignettes include the wildlife of North America, from polar bears and Newfoundland dogs to bison and alligators, a ship stuck in ice and a steam train crossing a bridge over a high gorge. Although Texas is shown as part of the USA, a population table lists it separately.

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
