A detailed plan of London, extending to Chelsea in the south west, clockwise to Hyde Park, Paddington, Islington, Hoxton, Stepney, Rotherhithe & St George's Fields. Under the map is a table of Hackney cab fares. This map was first issued in 1790. As London expanded the key was re-engraved to extend the plan further south.

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
