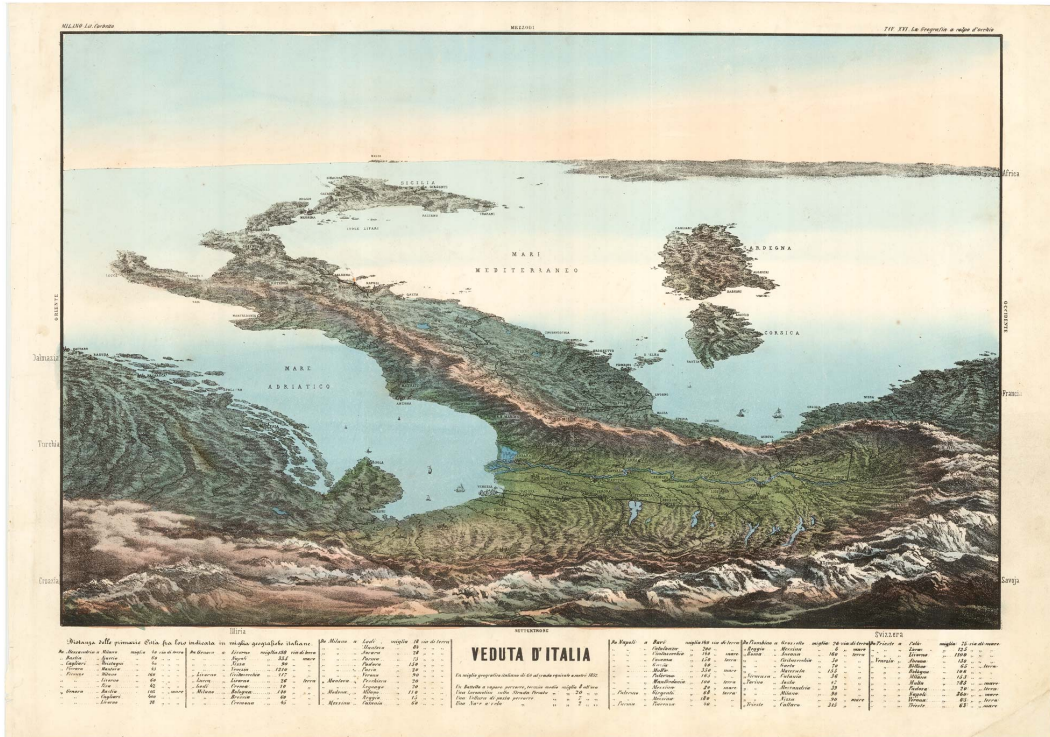




An unusual 'upside down' map-view of Italy
