A map of North America from the Great Lakes south to Panama, with the West Indies and insets details of Panama, Havana, Cartagena and Vera Cruz. The map is marked with the routes of the Spanish treasure ships; this and the large sea battle illustrated bottom left highlight the tensions between Britain, France and Spain in the region. Based on De L'Isle of 1703, this map was first published by Seutter in the 1740s. This example was published after Lotter took over his father-in-law's business in 1758.

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
